<b>Landscapes</b> – using the inspiration of the Gorge or a drawing you have brought with you, make a plaque to hang on the wall	all			
<b>Containers</b> – make coil or slab pots to your own design and shape	all			
<b>Sgraffito</b> – Use the patterns you find in the collections to inspire you then scratch out a unique design on a clay tile	1/2			
<b>Transfer design</b> – Make an intaglio print to see how this method was used to produce designs on ceramic ware. Then decorate a mug using a range of modern transfers.	2-4
